9.30am Arrival at Tanagh OETC Field Studies Classroom

- **Introduction to the topic:** Aims and objectives for the day. Presentation with an overview of the theory and some background information. Plan the investigation and divide up into teams.

Short break. Change into wetsuits, wellingtons etc. Depending on the weather.

Bus to river location

- **A quick survey:** Survey of river features and environment
- **Methods are demonstrated:** how to use the various types of geographical field studies equipment and fill in the recording sheets.
- **Collection of data:** All the primary data for the investigation is gathered using various methods of measuring and sampling.

Bus back to centre. Change into dry clothes. Short break

Restart session in the classroom

- **Graphing the data:** Examine the data, convert units and decide on the most appropriate types of graph. Graph and plot the data collected.

This Course concentrates on the 2022 topic; An investigation into the impact of the geomorphic processes of transport and /or deposition on the shaping of the landscape in a fluvial environment. This timetable represents a typical day but courses and content can be tailored to meet the specific needs of your group.

Equipment/Clothing required: Swimwear and towel. Spare clothes, hat and extra pair of old runners or wellingtons. Notebook and pencil.

Note: if water levels are low and the weather mild it will not be necessary for students to wear wetsuits.
